


Performance Indicators: Access









In Grades 7 to 10, 97% (2,149 out of 2,219) of the learners fall outside the normal status.

First quarter of SY 2016-2017, some teachers participated in trainings for different subjects, Division Learning Action Cell (DLAC), and ICT.




17. Learner - Seat Ratio

15. Learner-Classroom Ratio






There have been an insufficient number of classrooms for junior learners. Classrooms are overcrowded. Seats are not enough for all our students. In senior class there were enoughclassrooms.

The number of toilet bowls is not enough to accommodate all the students. It extremely shows that toilets are in great need by this school.






The biggest source of school funding come from the Donors. Other sources are MOOE, canteen fund, LGUs, and PTA.


7. Number and Rate of dropouts by cause









9. National Achievement Test (NAT) by Mean Percentage Score (MPS)








